1. MyLaps TRANSPONDER X2 SYSTEM

- A. Barona Speedway uses the MyLaps X2 Transponders. All classes except Junior Divisions, UTV's and Lawn Mowers will be using these transponders starting this year. It will be the responsibility of ALL Car Owners/Drivers to acquire a transponder before opening day on April 6, 2019..
- 1). The MyLaps brand transponder that we will be using will be X2 Car (red Stripe).
 - a). If you are looking to purchase an X2, please be sure there is a red stripe on the face of the transponder.
 - b). There are other color X2's for different types of racing events (MX, Karts, Motocross, etc. but only the X2 Car (Red Stripe) will be used at Barona Speedway.
 - 2). Some of the earlier versions of MyLaps/AMB Car Transponders will work with this X2 system. The transponder must be from MyLaps and have a serial number on it.
 - 3). All classes except Junior Divisions, UTV's and Lawn Mowers will be using these X2 transponders starting this year.

2. TRANSPONDER RENTAL INFORMATION

- A. The track will have a limited amount of transponder units available for rent race nights at a rate of \$40 per night.
- 1). You will have to surrender your driver's license until the transponder is returned.
- B. Rental returns are due at the end of your feature race. You will not receive your license until you return the rental transponder.
- 1). If you mistakenly take the transponder home with you, you will have the next day to return it. Every day after that first day will be an extra \$25 charge.
 - 2). (For example – if you rent the transponder on a Saturday night, take it home by accident and bring it back Sunday, there will be no charge. If you bring it back Monday, it will be a \$25 charge. Tuesday a \$50 charge, etc.)
 - 3). **You must call the speedway Management at xxxxxxxxxxxx to set up a time to bring in the transmitter.**

3. RACECAR MOUNTING LOCATIONS

- A. **Modified.**
- 1). Right Rear engine mounting plate (preferably on the rear side) (**OR**)
 - 2). Right Frame Rail just in front of firewall.

B. Pure and Street Stocks.

- 1). On front right side of firewall in engine compartment.

C. Pro and Stock Pony.

- 1). On front right side of firewall in engine compartment.

D. Dwarf.

- 1). Behind the driver on the rear firewall **OR**
- 2). Behind the driver on the roll cage behind rear firewall.

4. MOUNTING INSTRUCTIONS

- A. All transponders should be mounted no higher than 2' off the ground on the proper brackets.
- B. All transponders must be mounted with the silver pin pointing toward the sky.
- C. Make sure the transponder has a completely unobstructed sight to the track.
 - 1). Metal or carbon fiber below the transponder could block the signal.
- D. **DO NOT** mount the transponder near high current AC wiring or systems.
- E. **DO NOT** wrap wire or any metal material around transponder to assist in secure placement on bracket.
- F. Plastic Tie Wraps or Cable Ties are OK.
- G. If a hole needs to be cut in the body of the car it must be 8" in diameter and the tip of the transponder must extend just below the opening

5. INTERPRETATION OF THE RULES

Though we have made every effort to provide rules that will be clear and precise, should there be any confusion in your interpretation, **ASK!! IGNORANCE IS NOT AN EXCUSE!** If a specific issue is not addressed in these rules, the official's decision is final. Any modifications not addressed in these rules will not be allowed unless approved by the Tech.

We want all cars to be competitive with each other in their division. If you do something with your car that has been overlooked in these rules that we feel gives you an unfair advantage over your competitors, YOU will be required to change YOUR car.

These rules are provided to maintain orderly conduct of racing events and to establish requirements. By participating in events at Barona Speedway, each driver agrees to comply with these rules and all general rules of the Speedway.

Should your car be found in violation of these rules it will be the Tech's discretion as to what action will be taken. A minor 1st time infraction may allow you to race that night, but require you to make necessary changes prior to the next race.

Any rule infraction will be given to you in writing. Should a racing advantage rule infraction be found, you may be asked to start in the back, or may not be scored or allowed to place in that event. Changes will need to be made to your car to comply with the rules prior to the next race night.

These rules will be in effect throughout the 2019 racing season. These rules are in no way meant to imply any guarantee of safety. There is no guarantee against injury or death to participants, spectators or others.

These rules may be amended at any time by the Official. Changes may be made for safety, or to keep the competition close.

The Barona Speedway management appreciates your cooperation in complying with these rules. We wish you all a safe and successful 2019 racing season.
